## English Prerequisite

${ }^{1}$ One of the following: a minimum 67\% in English Studies 12, Literary Studies 12, English First Peoples 12, or equivalent; a university-level English or communications course for which Langara awards transfer credit; or a minimum "C" grade in ENGL 1120; or a minimum "C-" grade in ENGL 1121; or an "S" grade in ENGL 1107, 1108, or 1110; or LET with a minimum Level 3; or LEAP 8; or LPI with a minimum 26 on the essay and one of 5 in English usage, 5 in sentence structure, or 10 in reading comprehension.
